*The Rohrabacher amendment to HR 5326 (2013 Appropriations Bill), which would have defunded federal enforcement action in “medical” marijuana states, thankfully FAILED with a final vote of 262 to 163, a significant margin. The amendment would have put an end to the very effective actions being taken by the U.S. Attorneys and DEA that are helping states take back their communities from drug dealers.

Please note these significant facts:

Approximately 90% of Republicans voted “no.”

Approximately 30% of Democrats also voted "no," despite the fact that Nancy Pelosi (in a nod to her San Francisco constituents) was a strong supporter of the amendment. Significantly, however, she did NOT use her whip powers to force an even more consistent Democratic vote.
